Co-Chair: Just starting out not much to report. He is looking forward to the rest of the year. Thank you. Recommended for approval by Jamie – Approved.


Committees:

1. **Help emails**: Two emails were received in February and each was handled in an expedient manner, with one member being contacted offline to discuss getting family members involved in AA. Nothing else to report.
