have been making financial plans to attend via zoom, a motion was made to

future assemblies as in-person only. Also, considering the problems they had

at previous hybrid assemblies, concerning zoom participants being able to

attend via zoom you may do so and you will be allowed to vote. The DCMs

at that meeting.
