What is Sponsorship?

A sponsor in AA is someone who can help guide us through the program of AA and more specifically, the 12 Steps. This person is generally someone who has a good amount of sobriety under their belt and feels comfortable guiding others through difficult times in sobriety. A sponsor is an understanding and sympathetic person who you can trust and turn to with problems associated with alcohol and sobriety. Sponsorship is a vital tool for the 12 Step pathway of recovery. Although there are no formal sponsorship rules, it's recommended that a sponsor have at least one to two years of sobriety before they begin to sponsor. 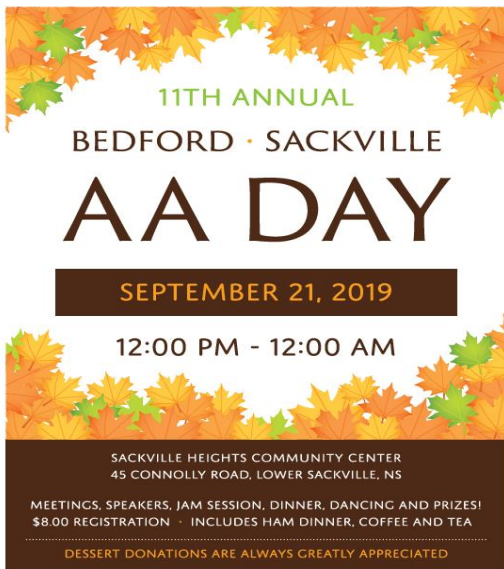
