Carrying the Message Inside and Out

As Alcoholics Anonymous does not hold records of individual members, it is difficult to establish how many of its current membership first made contact with AA while in prison but anecdotal evidence suggests that many of those who attend prison meetings continue to attend AA on release and go on to lead sober and worthwhile lives on the outside. The following is an extract from a personal sharing of a member who found AA in prison. "AA has transformed the lives of many inmates. Our actions and thoughts have been put on a more positive footing. We try to practice the program in our daily living. This would be impossible if the hand of AA was not there to help and guide us. We no longer feel the pain, frustration, loneliness and fear that accompany the active alcoholic. We have thrown off the chains that bound us. Today we have freedom."
