The trustees Literature Committee is seeking stories from AA members with diverse backgrounds. This is in response to the 2022 Conference Advisory Action that the trustees' Literature Committee revise the pamphlet "Do You Think You're Different?" to update the stories to represent greater diversity.

The Trustees' Literature Committee requested that consideration be given to stories from multicultural populations, stories from A.A. members whose experience reflects multiple factors, and from diverse populations not addressed in other current A.A. literature.

Please encourage members in your area to write their personal stories for possible inclusion in the revised pamphlet "Do You Think You're Different." Stories should reflect "in a general way what we used to be like, what happened, and what we are like now."

The suggested format for typed manuscripts is 500-800 words, double spaced, in 12-point font. Handwritten manuscripts should be approximately 5 to 6 pages.

Please include your complete name, address, and email/phone information on the first page of your manuscript. A copy of your manuscript should be retained for your files.

The anonymity of all authors will be observed whether their story is selected for publication or not.

District 1 and 2 - AA Members,

The Area 82 Assembly rotates between St. John's, Cornerbrook, Sydney and Halifax. Districts 1&2 are asked to host when the meetings are in Halifax and become responsible to form a local committee. 2024, it is District's 1 & 2 rotational turn, and also coincides with elections of Area 82 Executive Service Positions.

What is an Area 82 (Election) Assembly? At this special meeting, held once every two years, the delegate is elected, along with area officers. It is common for little or no other business to be conducted.

In an election year, this assembly is scheduled in the fall, with plenty of time for the newly elected delegate and area officers to prepare to take office in the new cycle.

Who goes to these Assemblies?

The following trusted servants are typically voting members of an area assembly:

- GSRs — representing the conscience of the groups in the area
- DCMs — representing the conscience of the districts in the area
- Area officers — elected by the GSRs and DCMs to serve the area
- Area committee chairs — typically appointed by the area chair or elected by the assembly
- Area delegate — elected to represent the conscience of the area at the annual General Service Conference meeting.

Generally speaking, area assembly meetings are open to all A.A. members, but the group's vote is carried by the GSR. GSRs are already voting on their behalf.

So, it's a big deal! The main purpose is to elect a delegate who will represent the area's conscience at the annual General Service Conference, where decisions are made that affect A.A. throughout the U.S. & Canada!

This email is a *call out* to all AA members of District 1 and 2, who would like to participate as a Committee in planning this event to set it up for success! You may be going, you may have a vote! But, before any of that can happen, there has to be a meeting place, and a place to stay, etc. The event's date is 11-13 October, 2024.

We will be looking for a Chair, Co-Chair, Treasurer, Registration Chair, and a Secretary to keep it all together.
